



## Sauvignon Blanc 2014

A sheltered north-facing valley on the upper terraces above the Kawarau River at Bannockburn is home to Domain Road Vineyard. The unique terroir with unusual soils and distinctive microclimate make this old gold mining area ideal for producing premium cool climate wines.

Sauvignon Blanc vines are planted in two locations — on Templar's Hill, untouched by the 19th century gold miners and on Doctor's Flat, where mining has exposed rich mineral clays atop a 10-million year old lake bed.

## The Wine

The grapes have been hand harvested on 8th April 2014. After de-stemming and lightly crushing, the grapes were pressed and 28% was transferred to French Oak barriques to barrel ferment. The rest of the wine was fermented in closed top stainless steel fermenters. A touch of residual sugar has been retained to provide balance and poise to the natural acidity of the wine.

The colour of pale straw our Sauvignon Blanc is a dry style, complex wine with a mouth filling creamy texture, balanced acidity and a long crisp finish. Aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit and citrus on the nose are complemented by intense flavours of tropical fruit, stonefruit and gooseberry on the palate.
