



Paradise Pinot Noir 2009 - Single Vineyard

Domain Road vineyard lies in the heart of the historic Bannockburn gold mining area of Central Otago. Many traces of the lives led by these early settlers can still be seen, from the network of water races to the old stone cottage lying at the heart of the vineyard.

The summers are hot, the autumns long and dry, and the winters cold – perfect for Pinot Noir grape-growing. When combined with high quality loam overlaying schist gravels and ‘pipe clay’, the result is premium cool climate wines that win awards around the world.

The Wine

Harvested in mid-April 2009 from a mix of clones that were cropped at one bunch per shoot and fermented ‘wild’, the wine was aged in French oak barriques for around 14 months.

Aromas of rich, dark plum with dried herbs and spices combine with hints of earthy complexity. On the palate, the wine has dense dark plum and cherry fruit with ample chewy tannin, giving the wine excellent weight and good persistence.
