



Pinot Noir Rosé 2010

Domain Road Vineyard is situated in a small sheltered valley in the heart of the historic gold mining village of Bannockburn. The unique microclimate of the area, long known to the local population, is proving ideal for the production of premium wine grapes. The Pinot Noir fruit for this Rosé has been carefully selected from a vineyard area sheltered from prevailing winds by surrounding hills. The fruit has been carefully tended to produce a complex mix of flavours and create a superbly flavoursome wine.

The Wine

Made from 100% Pinot Noir fruit, the grapes were harvested on 12 April 2010. The fruit was whole bunch pressed and about 20% of the juice was fermented in older French Oak barriques to increase the mouth feel and complexity of the wine. The remaining portion underwent a slow, cool fermentation in stainless steel until the ferment was stopped to retain a touch of residual sugar.

This Pinot Noir Rosé displays lifted aromas of raspberries, cherries, and confectionary. A dry style Rosé, the wine has a creamy texture with predominant flavours of red berries and stone fruit.
