



Pinot Noir Rosé 2012

Domain Road Vineyard is tucked away in the village of Bannockburn, near Cromwell, Central Otago, an area famous for its 19th century gold fields. A unique micro-climate of hot summers and snowy winters provides perfect conditions for growing diverse grape varieties.

The Pinot Noir vines have been planted to take advantage of the shelter provided by the surrounding hills. This gives the grapes a complex mix of flavours that create a superbly flavoursome wine.

The Wine

Our Pinot Noir Rosé is made from 100-per cent Pinot Noir grapes, that were hand harvested on 19th April 2012. The fruit was destemmed, crushed, and held cold overnight to allow the juice to pick up colour from contact with the skins. The fruit was then pressed before fermenting. The fermentation was stopped while a touch of residual sugar remained in order to balance the wine's natural acidity.

With aromas of lifted strawberry, ripe Peaches and confectionary, this wine will transport you back to a quieter, gentler time. Dry in style with a soft creamy texture enhanced by the essence of red berry fruits, culminating in a long lingering finish.
