



Pinot Noir Rosé 2023

Domain Road Vineyard is tucked away in the village of Bannockburn, near Cromwell, Central Otago, an area famous for its 19th century gold fields. A unique micro-climate of hot summers and frosty winters provide perfect conditions for growing diverse grape varieties.

Our vines have been planted to take advantage of the shelter provided by the surrounding hills. This gives the grapes a complex mix of flavours that create a superbly flavoursome wine.

The Wine

The grapes were hand harvested from Domain Road Vineyard on the 17th April 2023. The fruit was whole bunch pressed to a stainless steel tank for cold settling for two days. The juice was then racked and inoculated with selected wine yeast. The cool fermentation was stopped to retain a touch of residual sugar.

With its traditional pale pink colour, our Rosé is aromatic with rose petal, strawberry, cherry blossom and ripe melon on the nose. A crisp dry wine it delivers nectarine, white peach, lime and cotton candy on the palate.

Complex, with good minerality and a well-rounded mouthfeel that is balanced with bright acidity and a touch of fruit sweetness in the finish.

Food matches: Chicken, oysters, shellfish, soft cheeses. Also starters and hors d'oeuvres. Grilled vegetable salad or, in summer, watermelon and feta salad.
