



## Pinot Noir Rosé 2022

Domain Road Vineyard is tucked away in the village of Bannockburn, near Cromwell, Central Otago, an area famous for its 19th century gold fields. A unique micro-climate of hot summers and frosty winters provide perfect conditions for growing diverse grape varieties.

Our vines have been planted to take advantage of the shelter provided by the surrounding hills. This gives the grapes a complex mix of flavours that create a superbly flavoursome wine.

## The Wine

The grapes were hand harvested from Domain Road Vineyard over two picks on 6th and 9th April 2022. The fruit was whole bunch pressed to a stainless steel tank for cold settling for two days. The juice was then racked and inoculated with selected wine yeast. The cool fermentation was stopped to retain a touch of residual sugar.

With its traditional pale pink colour, our Rosé is aromatic with raspberry, strawberry, peach and white melon on the nose. A crisp dry wine it delivers sweet stone fruit, red berries, ripe strawberry and a hint of citrus on the palate.

Complex, with good levels of concentration and minerality, leading to a cherry finish.

Food matches: Chicken, oysters, shellfish, soft cheeses. Also starters and hors d'oeuvres. Grilled vegetable salad or, in summer, watermelon and feta salad.
