



QUEENSTOWN 7 DAY FAMILY PACKAGE

ITINERARY

Please note: We want to ensure you get the most out of your ski/board days and for this reason our guides will monitor the weather to see what mountain is most appropriate. Please use this itinerary as a guide only.

Day 1 – Saturday

Arrival Day – We will arrange transport for you from the airport

Arrive into Queenstown airport at a time that suits you, and we will arrange transport for you from the airport.

Depending on your arrival time, you could fit in one or two of the many family friendly activities (Zipride, Shotover Jet, and Kiwi Birdlife Park). Your guide will make sure you are acquainted with Queenstown, and take you to the supermarket to stock up on snacks and supplies if needed.

Day 2 – Sunday

Please be waiting in the lobby at 7.30am – Cardrona Ski Resort (60 minutes)

Your guide will pick you up this morning and cannot wait to show you the slopes, but firstly we need to pick up rental equipment for those who need it (skis, boots, clothing, a toboggan, and anything else needed). Once we are on the road, we head to Cardrona a 60-minute drive away.

Cardrona is a fun, family friendly mountain a great place for kids to learn to ski/snowboard. The resort has excellent learner and intermediate terrain for developing skills and confidence, and they offer all types of ski/snowboard lessons, for all levels. Beginner lessons are also available for the little ones, as young as 2 years old and freestyle lessons for the older more extreme kids in the family!

The adults do not have to miss out, brush up your skills by joining in a group lesson or a private lesson. No matter what you choose to do, your guide will make sure everyone is in the right place at the right time, having fun.



Day 3 – Monday

*Please be waiting in the lobby at 9.00am
– Coronet Peak (25 minutes)*

Today we let you have that well deserved sleep in before we hit Coronet Peak, just a 25-minute drive away. Coronet Peak is perfect for everyone; the terrain is rolling and fun. A huge base area makes grabbing lunch a breeze, along with plenty of outdoor seating.

Day 4 – Tuesday

Day off snow

Your host gets you sorted no matter what you choose to do, whether it is choosing activities or hitting the best shops. If you want to relax and go your own way that is fine too. There are many sites in Queenstown and check out the multitude of activities available, perhaps even a day trip to the magnificent Milford Sound – what a great way to rest the legs.

Day 5 – Wednesday

*Please be waiting in the lobby at 8.00am
– The Remarkables (40 minutes)*

The Remarkables have a relaxed atmosphere, sun-kissed slopes, and dedicated learning facilities. The Remarkables is serious fun for families and big kids at heart, let your guide show the way to follow the sun around all the slopes and avoid the crowds. A huge learner's area right next to the base lodge makes it ideal for kids to learn and have fun.

Day 6 – Thursday

Please be waiting in the lobby at 8.00am

Day four on snow takes us to the resort with the best weather and snow for the day. Your guide will have studied the weather and snow conditions intently, choosing the best resort for the day. Each resort has different aspects, which affects how much fresh snow they get or how sheltered they are from weather. If it is blue skies and calm weather everywhere, well, you get to choose!

Day 7 – Friday

Please be waiting in the lobby at 8.00am

Your final day on snow will be at the crowds favourite, the guide will of course help by letting you know the current weather situation. At the end of the day, celebrate a fantastic snow holiday, with a stop on the way home to enjoy a hot chocolate, ice cream or drink at one of the local's secret spots your guide knows.
